




THE 2022-2025 STRATEGIC PLAN

The development of this plan required enclosed documents, which are essential to the achievement of the ambitions, revealed by the said plan, in particular the resource mobilization plan, the communication plan and the action plan. Documents necessary for the implementation of the strategic plan. Thus, it is accompanied by the work that the achievement of the objectives set requires more resources than those that Muslim Hands Mali traditionally benefits from the funding offices.

So in order to be able mobilize funding from institutions, Muslim Hands Mali will start the communication and resource mobilization plan in order to give itself the means to achieve its objectives for the happiness of the populations.



MOBILIZATION OF PARTNERS

Muslim Hands Mali in coordination with HIPD has taken specific steps in order to mobilize partners around its strategic plan. This approach aim to mobilize as many partners as possible to establish a long-term partnership with Muslim Hands Mali. This partnership will develop the nexus approach in order to link development to humanitarian action. Due to COVID-19 pandemic, several partners are reluctant to face-to-face meetings, but the first responses immediately fell because of the notoriety that the organization has made in the country through its actions which are out of the ordinary and which are very visible in terms of impact.

Conclusion


With Our Partners
