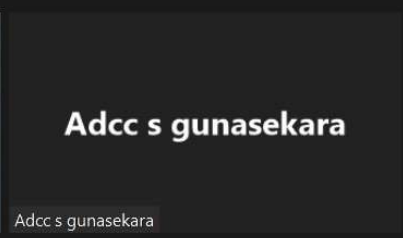

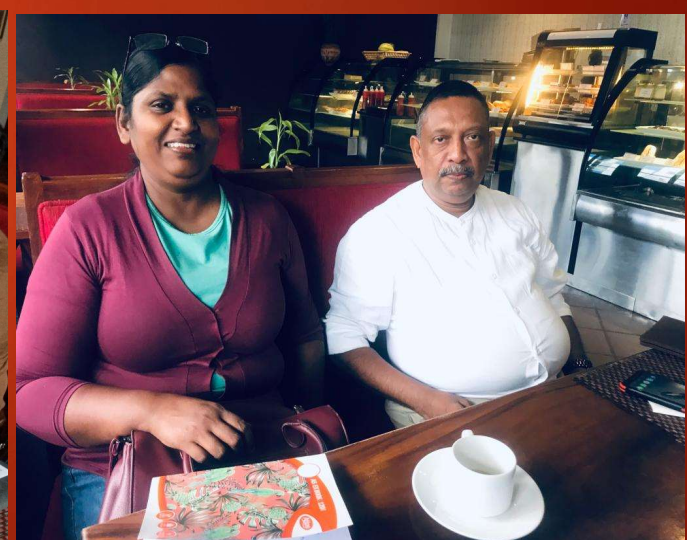

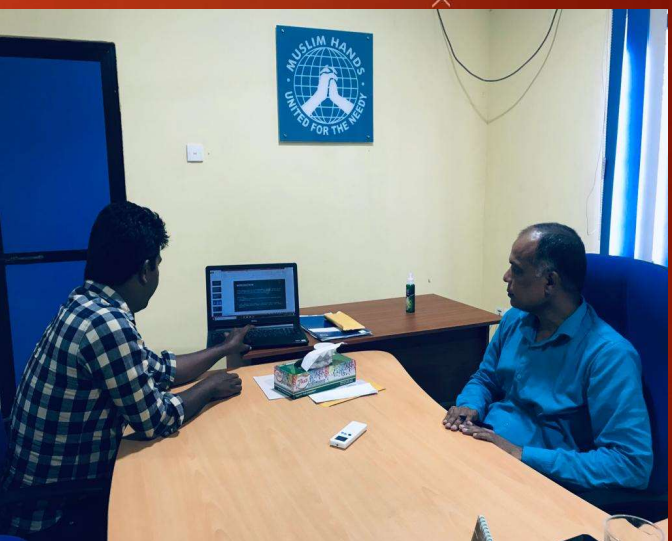

One person in five around the world has no access to safe drinking water. Due to climate change, drought, lack of opportunity and poverty, many vulnerable families across Sri Lanka face difficulties to access safe water. Recent researches claim that, people are more exposed to drinking arsenic contaminated water and caused for chronic kidney diseases

MHSL provides clean water to every community that it work with. We seek to minimize environmental impact through innovations. MHSL is implementing Dug a Well (DAW) project, Tube Wells with electric motor system, Community Wells, Water Supply Systems through constructing deep wells and water filtration system by installing RO plants for the poor and needy families from Mannar, Puttalam, Anuradhapura, Kurunegala, Trincomalee and Batticaloa districts in order to provide access to clean drinking water for all communities.

Hygiene practice becomes vital concern where the usage of water from the dug well. Normally MHSL conduct awareness on hygiene promotion to the identified families with the support of Public Health Inspector from Health Sector. MHSL has constructed latrines for the needy families.

In 2022, MHSL have reached 90,000 beneficiaries from 15,000 families. Nearly 1,000 various type of safe water points we have installed. The project has been implemented by MHSL with support of MHUK and MHFR.

We (MHSL) are expecting more WASH projects to cover needier around Sri Lanka.

Emergency; Sri Lanka Economic Crisis

- ▶ After 30 years of civil war and Natural and Manmade disasters, especially Tsunami devastation in Sri Lanka, the country's economy is heavily destroyed. Flooding, Drought, Landslides and Wild life attacking and many more disasters are annually happening in Sri Lanka.
- ▶ During these emergencies MHSR has regularly responding humanitarian activities partnering with government and public stakeholders. MHSR is one of the leading agencies on the disaster management sector in Sri Lanka since Tsunami devastation.
- ▶ At the moment, Sri Lanka is facing the worst economic crisis. The economy has hit rock bottom as it defaulted on international loans and is facing rampant fuel and food shortages, and the government is struggling to manage the situation.
- ▶ After the civil war ended in 2009, then regime took out massive foreign loans to pay for war expenses and, more importantly, to start flashy infrastructure projects to attract tourism and reward associates. The 2019 Easter bombings and the COVID-19 pandemic ravaged tourism, Sri Lanka's main source of foreign revenue.

These days Sri Lanka is struggling to pay for crucial imports like food, fuel and medicine for its 23 million people as it battles a foreign exchange crisis. Inflation has soared about 50% and more, with food prices 80% higher than a year ago. The Sri Lankan rupee has slumped in value against the US dollar and other major global currencies this year.

Due to this crisis many people lost their employment and their income source. Many others struggled to run their own businesses. Day-to-day expenditure was seen to rise to high. People are not able to earn sufficient income and thus the people living in the poverty line and middle income earners also greatly affected.

To responding the situation, Muslim Hands Sri Lanka has come forward to distribute dry food packs to the people who have greatly affected by the economic downturn. For these, 1200 vulnerable marginalized families selected from Puttalam and Kinniya areas with guidance of the government officials. 6000 direct beneficiaries have reached through emergency food aid program.

The situation is going worse day to day and there are huge need for the humanitarian assistance to cope up the situation and let them to engage various livelihood and income generation activities by themselves.

The key objective of this project is to share the blessings of Qurbani with the needy people of Sri Lanka.

Seasonal (Food Aid) Program

Ramadan – Ifthar and Dry Food (Zakat) Packs

Month of Ramadan is a blessing of Allah (SWT). The Muslims all over the world use this holiest opportunity to support the needy by their Zakat, Sadaka allocations and expecting rewards from almighty Allah (SWT). Supporting the poor and needy who observe fasting during the holiest month of Ramadan is a highly rewarded deeds. The holy Islam has guided to support the poor and needy by providing; Ifthar meals, Zakat and Sadaka donations (Dry Food Packs) to prepare their Zuhr meals and in the end of the month Zakat Ul Fithr and support to prepare the Eid Ul Fithr festival.

As usual this year too MHSL has distributed 1433 dry food packs among the marginalized vulnerable families (consisting 7165 individual beneficiaries) who are living below the poverty line. The families were selected from Kinniya, Mannar and Puttalam districts of Sri Lanka. Through the Ramadan Dry Foods and Qurbani Meat Distributions thousands of poorest and needy families including widows and orphans annually have been benefited.



Qurbani- Fresh Meat Packs

Qurbani is the custom of sharing meat with families and the poor at the end of the Hajj season to celebrate Eid Al-Adha. MHSL provides Qurbani meat to the needy families in Sri Lanka with generous funding support from charity donors. The key objective of this project is to share the blessings of Qurbani with the needy people of Sri Lanka.

This year's Qurbani program was held with much critical acclaim. Mannar, Anuradhapura, Mullaithivu, Puttalam and Kinniya regions were selected for this year Qurbani distribution. An about 15,000 poorest and needy families including widows and orphans have been benefited. 450 bulls were slaughtered and distributed in Mannar area as a change from the usual practice with the support of MHUK. Also, arrangements were made to distribute Qurbani parcels among School of Excellence orphan children.

MHSL office best utilize the orphans' sponsorship fund for food, health, clothing, education, and all-round mental and physical uplift of the orphans. The program has been continuing since last 10 years for betterment orphans children in Sri Lanka. MHFR, MHUK, MHSA and ISRC has been supporting Sri Lanka to get sponsorship. Currently, Muslim Hands Sri Lanka has more than 400 Sponsored Children. They are continuously monitored by supervisors and mentors deployed by MHSL.

During the year (2022) MHFR's orphans' children has received stationary items such as school bag, exercise books, school uniforms and shoes in addition to the monthly sponsorship amount. As the good practice and support the children, MHFR has announced to enrolled needy non-Muslim orphans children to the program.

Through Education Program MHSL aim to give the children the skills they need to create a sustainable, brighter future for themselves and their communities. MHSL empowers children by providing sponsorship for education upliftment, constructing building for schools, providing educational supplies and materials.

MHSL is running an English medium school named "School of Excellence" which started in the year 2010 with two primary classes. Alhamdulillah, after the establishment of School of Excellence, the people of this area are very much delighted to see their children learning in English medium. From far area (45KM) also students attend School. MHSL, with the support of the benevolent Donors, has eradicated a major problem and fulfilled a vital need of the orphans, poor and needy children of the area. Though there is free education in Government schools the parents of the fee-paying students prefer the teaching of English medium education at SOE. At the moment it has almost 850 student population and classes up to General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE AL) from LKG.

In Sri Lanka, Children from remote villages are forced to travel miles to go to school to continue basic education. The parents are from remote area their economy is merely depended upon daily wage labor, fishing and livestock development. The education supports such as primary education buildings, bicycle to reach school on time and school stationeries to cope up with current economic crisis are highly needed.

Also, MH has established School of Excellence for the betterment of vulnerable families where more than 850 children continue their studies.

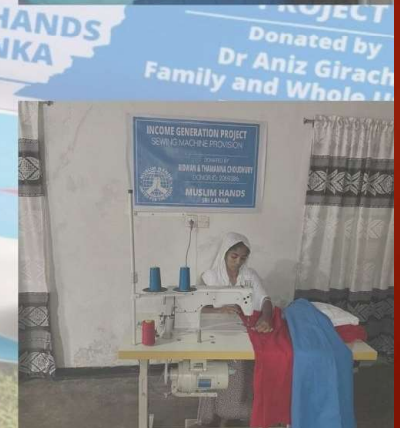

As due to current economic recession in the country, many has failed to succeed in their business activities and some lost job opportunities. Recent research found that, middle class families and low-income level families have been drastically affected by the recession and still struggling to come to light.

Considering economic conditions of the people, this year too, it was started in an effort to identify the families who are backward in their livelihood in the difficult situation of the country and provide them with livelihood facilities to raise their standard of living. 11 small shops for 11 vulnerable/low-income earning families, 15 goat farming to the 15 families with 4 nannies and 1 goat for each family and 2 canoes with fishing net were given to two fishermen families. For this provision Mannar, Anuradhapura and Batticaloa districts were selected.



Livelihood

The objectives of the livelihood and economic development program are to enhance income earning capacities of the poor families in the selected areas and inculcating a sense of self - dependency among the poor by providing them with a suitable income generating mechanism purely dependent on their commitment and efforts towards the success of their livelihood activity.

The livelihood program is a part of MHSL's efforts to combat poverty levels and raise living standards among the poverty-stricken rural village folk. MHSL's past interventions were focused needy families from Mannar, Trincomalee, Batticaloa, Puttalam and Anuradhapura districts in order to make them self-sustained.

MHSL implements different kinds of livelihood activities depending on the capacity, capabilities and the experiences of the beneficiaries. Those activities include cattle farming, poultry farming, home gardening, fishing, grocery shops and many other self-employments. MHSL also provides skills training which will be useful in developing the businesses which they are engaged in.

As due to current economic recession in the country, many has failed to succeed in their business activities and some lost job opportunities. Recent research found that, middle class families and low-income level families have been drastically affected by the recession and still struggling to come to light.

Considering economic conditions of the people, this year too, it was started in an effort to identify the families who are backward in their livelihood in the difficult situation of the country and provide them with livelihood facilities to raise their standard of living. 11 small shops for 11 vulnerable/low-income earning families, 15 goat farming to the 15 families with 4 nannies and 1 goat for each family and 2 canoes with fishing net were given to two fishermen families. Shelter and Constructions

SHELTER & CONSTRUCTIONS

The shelter is basic needs of the human and its basic rights as well.
